1. Call for Contributions - EUROSUD Master's Programme

The EUROSUD – South European Studies Master, coordinated by Universidad Autónoma de Madrid (UAM), invites faculty from CIVIS member and associate partner universities to design and deliver one session for two courses:

Sessions should focus on a specific issue or political dimension relevant to Southern Europe (Medg countries, Balkans, or Turkey) and last **1h45min**, combining lecture and activities.
