1. “Green House Gang”

- Trained team of students - rewarded with ECTS - identifying carbon intense behaviour by:
 - Polls
 - Interviews
 - Observation of daily routines, device usage
 - investigating “bad-practice-reports”
- Small issues:
 - Fast feedback loops with the **committee**
- Large Issues:
 - Presenting information from fieldwork to the **council**
 - Evaluation and conception of solutions within the **council**
 - Awarding ‘bad practice-reports’ by uni members

2. Green Campus Council

Team of Experts consisting of:

- Members of *Green House Gang*
- City Officials
- Professors eg. environmental sciences
- Facility Manager
- Engineers
- AI Experts for smart solutions

Tasks:

- Discussing report from *Green House Gang*
- Finding smart, sustainable solutions
- reporting to **Green Campus Committee**
- specific problems can be discussed in project seminars

→ Finalisation: **Green Campus Committee** meeting with principal of university, administration and speaker of each team

- Raising awareness on sustainability using social media:
 - educating followers on how to live sustainably
 - using online Polls to decide on topics
 - video- documentation of implemented upgrades by the **green campus committee**
 - posts on how to be more sustainable in day to day life
