A EU leaders' initiative

European Universities creation is one of the flagship initiatives to build a **European Education Area**. The vision is that, across the EU:

- spending **time abroad to study** and learn should become the norm
- school and higher education **qualifications should be recognised across the EU**
- **knowing two languages** in addition to one's mother tongue should be standard
- everyone should be able to **access high-quality education**, irrespective of their socio-economic background
- people should have a strong sense of their **identity as a European**, of Europe's cultural heritage and its diversity

First call

- 54 applications
- 17 European Universities (12 initially foreseen)
- 114 higher education institutions (16 French) from 24 states
- Budget: €85 million
- 4 alliances coordinated by French universities

Second call

- 62 applications
- 24 new European Universities (41 in total)
- 165 higher education institutions from 26 member states
- Budget: €287 million (total)
- 2021: full roll-out under the future Erasmus programme

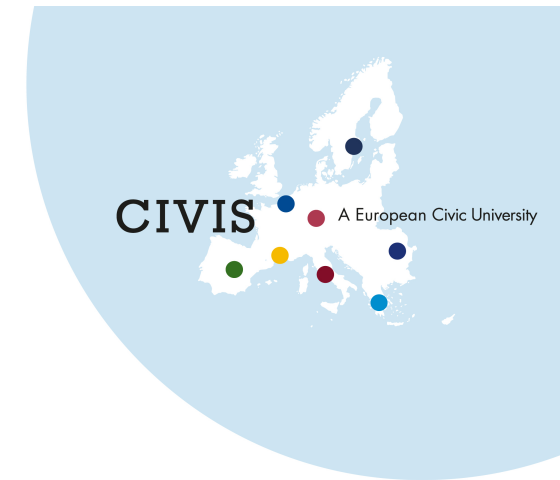

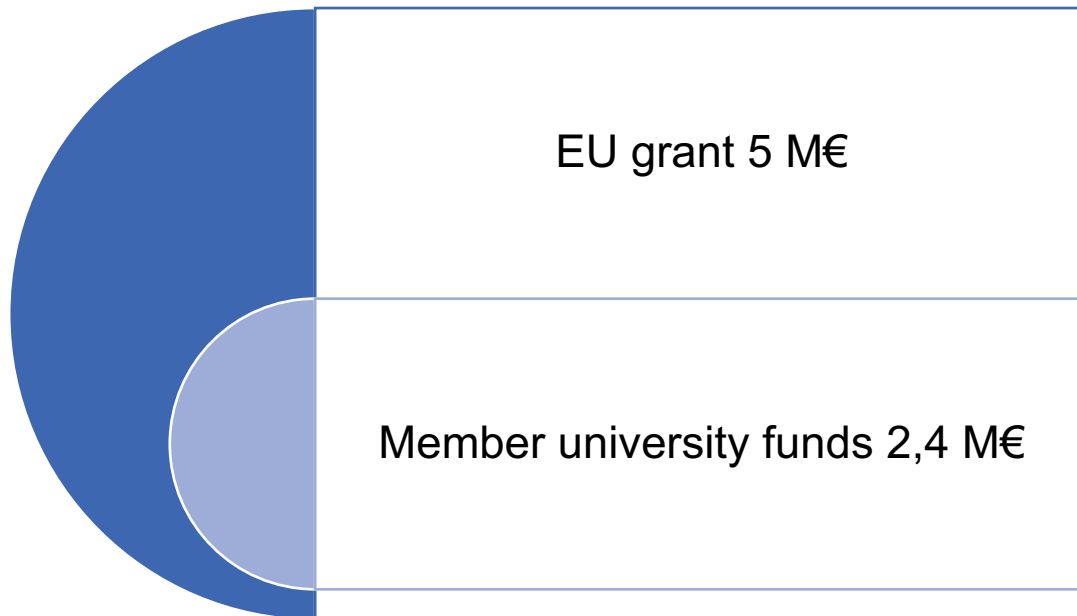

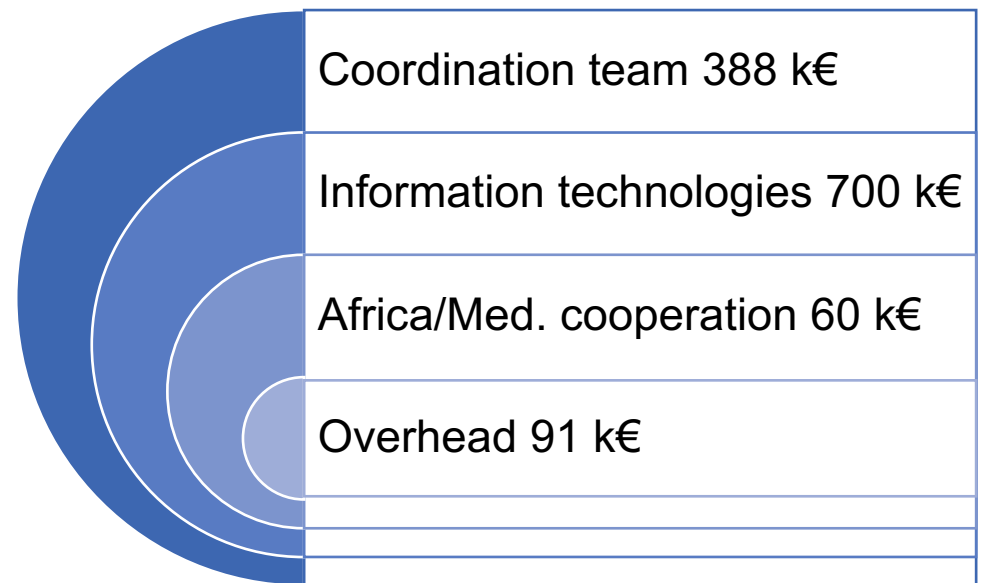
The budget over 3 years

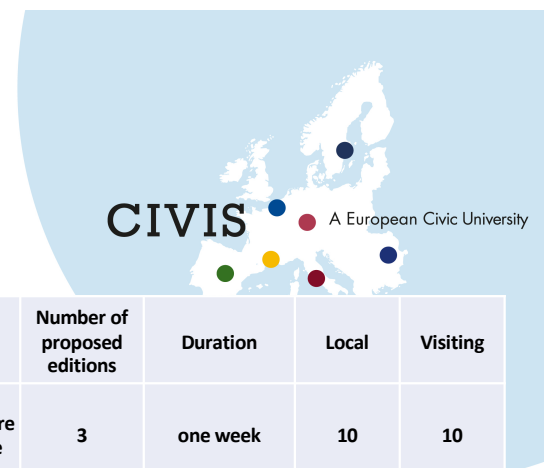
CIVIS calls

TF Education

- Works on propositions for the recognition of initiatives, training modules (mobility or collaborations) developed within CIVIS
- Looks for solutions to include CIVIS developments in existing training offers and unlocks obstacles

TF Doctoral Schools

- Reinforces coordination at the PhD level (co-tutelle, mobility...)

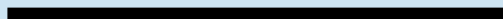

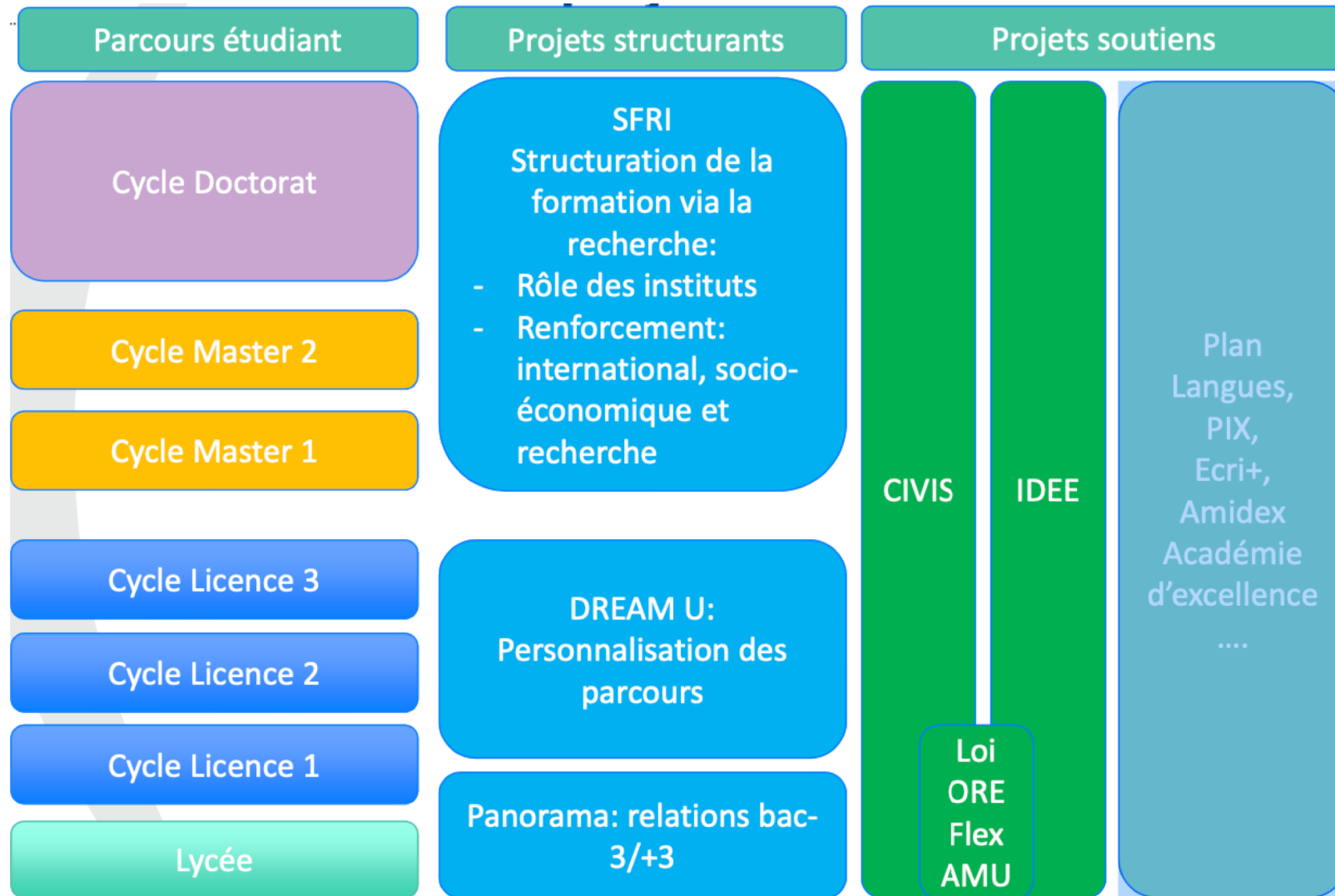

Covid: threats and opportunities



Threats

- No physical mobility
- Poor accessibility to digital equipment for the disadvantaged students
- Difficulties to reach the expected number of mobilities
- A more complex cooperation and collaboration

Opportunities

- All partners, except Bucharest, are located in the Schengen area. Travel restrictions are lifted at an earlier stage
- Virtual learning passed the crash test. Physical mobilities can be reduced in favour of virtual and blended mobilities
- Strong and reiterated support of the European Commission for the Alliances

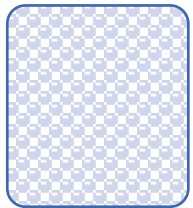

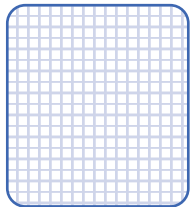

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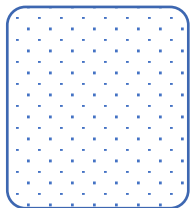
