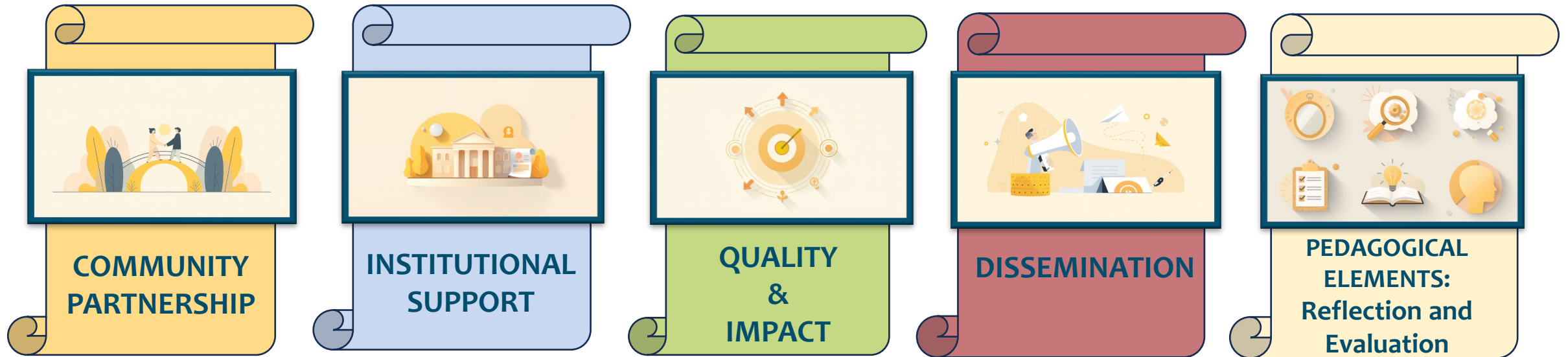
What is Service-Learning?



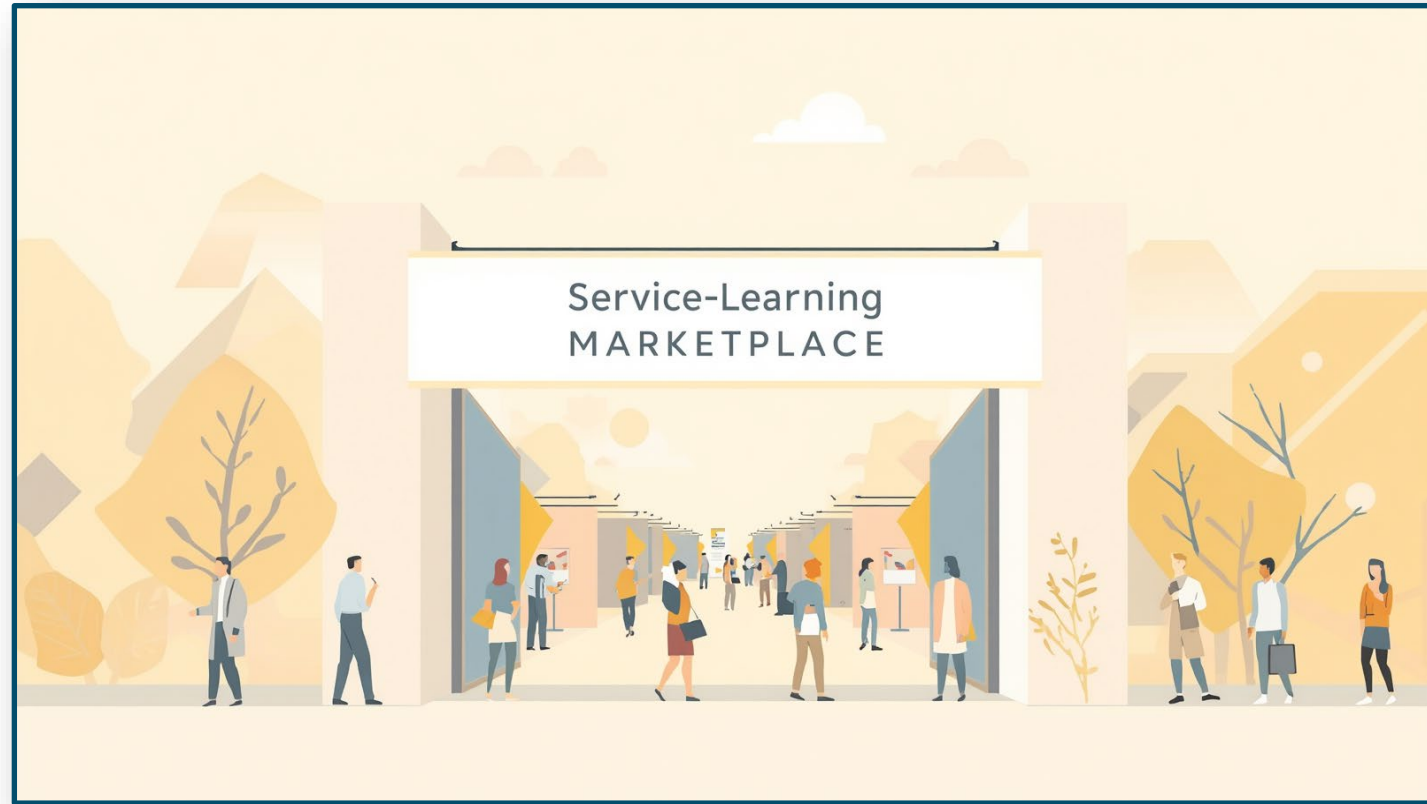
- applying academic knowledge into practice with a **social justice purpose**
