From Local to Global: Shaping the Future of International Education

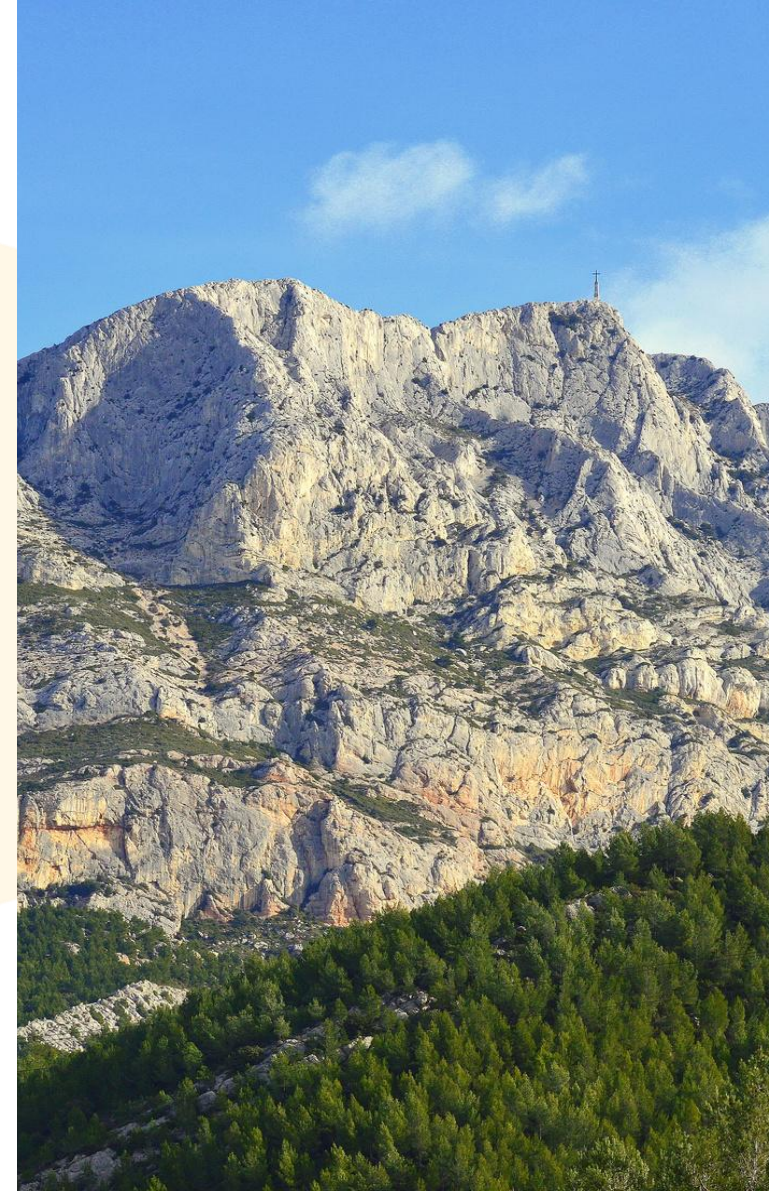
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Join us in Aix-en-Provence and take part in our STT
